**Treasurer's Report** –Roger gave update, current fund balance is \$23,524.33. The budget is broken down into 4 categories: General fund, Tri-city Challenge, Scholarships, Reinhardt scholarship.

Motion by Roger, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Alan to reimburse Lisa Ledebuhur for a banner for the Tri-City Challenge for \$176.34. Receipt given to Roger, and motion approved.

## **Tri-City Challenge Update**

- Still looking for volunteers, but this will be a continuous effort. Some ideas include Srs Give Back students, golf team members, community service students.
- New contributions from sponsors include \$250 from R and R Machining in Winona, use of ATV equipment from M and M Lawn and Leisure, \$500 from Farmer's Elevator. Jan Smaby and Brad Hoiness continue to work hard in this area.
- Timing Systems After researching costs and talking with other event organizers, Lisa recommends to use a manual timing system for the first event.
- Banners Received pricing from 3 vendors for banners, Wonderlnk being by far the cheapest at \$89 per banner for a 10' x 4' banner. We will order 2 more banners.
- T-Shirts Got pricing for long sleeve polyester t-shirts, cheapest estimate being around \$15 for 200 or more shirts. These types of shirts are a little more expensive, but thought to be a real attraction to participants. We did decide we will not offer t-shirts for those participating only in Conquer the Bluff, due to cost of participation being very low. We will explore offering a photo or water jug with Conquer the Bluff logo if we can get within the \$5 range.
