Announcements/Roll call - Chair Ledebuhr presided.

Approval of previous meeting minutes: Motion by Ryman, second by Linder, to approve minutes from August 12, 2016. Motion carried.

Bills: Moved by Lawston, seconded by Iverson, to approve paying the following three invoices. Motion carried.

Deposits: Checks were received from Rushford State Bank (\$250) and Ferndale (\$100) for Tri-County Challenge sponsorship. Additional sponsorships had been received earlier; a summary will be included at the next meeting.

Tri-City Challenge Run Bike Hike and Conquer the Bluff updates:

- Hengel reviewed the 5K route map and discussed the bike route; places where volunteers will need to be stationed were noted.
- Ledebuhr will contact Jenny Helgemoe and Jake Timm to follow up on the national honor society students working on a video.
- Ryman will send JPG files to post on Facebook; Ledebuhr will ask Helgemoe to share it on the alumni FB page; Lawston will have them inserted in the Friday folders and share on FB; Hoiness will print them for bag inserts at Rushford Foods over a weekend.
- Ryman will get postcards to Peterson and Rushford Taste of the Trail events, and to Roger Metz for Ride the Ridges.
- Both banners are done and will be hung on the school fence alongside Hwy 43/Mill Street.
- T-shirt samples were examined, and the group agreed on the shinier of the two fabrics.
- Ledebuhr will call M&M about ATVs.
- Ledebuhr will contact the City to notify the ambulance, police, and see if their utility cart would be available for emergencies on the bluff.
- Conquer the Bluff registration will be \$5/person, \$25/group of 6+, and we'll ask adults for free will donations.
- Ehler will provide two of the school vans from 10am-12noon to haul people from the top of the bluff if they don't want to walk back down.

Friends of the Foundation Fall Feast: A draft invitation was reviewed and approved, and it will be mailed out Friday, September 9. A small ad will also be placed in the Tri-County Record. Ryman noted Judy Christians (Stumpy's) will provide the hors d'oeuvres and beverages. Ryman will finalize arrangements for the rest of the

meal with Rodney Thompson. The group agreed we should use the same decorations as last year if they are available.
